### **Tuition Information**

**Tuition received on the 16<sup>th</sup> through the 22<sup>nd</sup> will be assessed a \$5.00 late fee. Tuition received on the 23<sup>rd</sup> through the 30<sup>th</sup> will be assessed a \$10.00 late fee.**

### **Substitute Teacher's Aid Training**

Training will be held next month for persons interested in volunteering in the classroom when a teacher or aide is absent. You need only to attend one of the days. This is a valuable way to give back to the school. Your service is greatly appreciated.

### **Fall Session of Stay & Play For 3's, 4's & 5's**

Look for Registration days listed on the calendar. This popular program allows your child to play with old friends, make new friends and meet other teachers. Sign up for the Fall Session. We need a minimum of 8 children to hold a session.

### **Hallway Traffic**

LCNS is a very busy school each morning. We have over 75 children arriving each day. Because of the hallway congestion, we will con-

tinue our modified scheduled again this year. Shepherds, Fishermen, Wisemen, Rainbows, Prophets, Little Lambs and Angels will open their doors about 9:25 and dismiss at 11:55. (Most rooms on the north side of the building.) This change has alleviated the large number of families arriving at the same time.

Please be mindful of the size of a stroller and restrain from bringing large strollers into the school hallways. The café ladies are more than willing to watch your other children while you take your child to class.
