The children are invited to wear green. The children will hear a knock on the door (by the "leprechaun"). They will follow the "foot prints" (placed by our volunteers) of the leprechaun in search for the pot of gold. The reward for their search throughout the building is hearing a story about leprechauns and receiving a piece of gold from the pot of gold. When the children return to the classroom, they will find that the "leprechaun" (our volunteers) have made a mess in the room, with overturned chairs, coats strewn about, and more. Directions for the Hat Parade

A. Drop off: bring children to the classroom with the hat.

B. For 3, 4, and 5 year old classes

Families go to Family Life Center and stand in the center of the room.

The teachers will bring classes down at 9:40 am or 12:55 pm and the children will parade around the outside of the room two times. There is plenty of time for pictures. We will end the parade with a group picture for each class.

C. For 2 year old classes

Families go to the room beside the school office and/or the hallway behind the Sanctuary. The teachers will bring the children down at 10:00 am. The children will parade around the hallways and you can take a group picture in the room beside the school office.

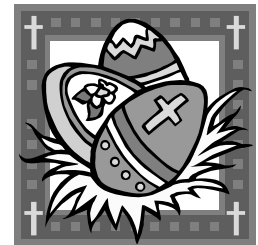
D. Conclusion of each parade
