Visit from the Fire Fighter

The 3, 4 and 5 year old children look forward to seeing the fire truck. Our emphasis is on learning basic fire safety and helping the children to understand that a firefighter is an adult who wears special clothing to fight fires.

Parent Teacher Conferences

The teachers are looking forward to meeting with you during our scheduled "Help Us Get To Know Your Child" conference. Due to limited time that day, please come with a list of questions or concerns you would like to share with the teacher. If the teacher feels that more time is needed, you may be asked to schedule an additional conference during the teachers' regularly scheduled work hours.

Please be on time for your conference and we will do our best to stay within your scheduled time. There will be no school for your child on that day. Each class is assigned one of two days for conferences. Carefully check the calendar for your child's conference day. Some classes will be in school while others are having conferences.

Child-care is available during your scheduled conference time in the Angels/Little Lambs room on the main level.

Sign up for childcare in the school office by Oct 12. If only a few families sign up, child care will be cancelled the week before.

Conference Schedule: The teachers will post a notice outside of the classroom with the times and families' names. If you are unable to come at the assigned time please trade with someone. Inform your child's teacher if you have traded or if you are unable to attend.

Conferences will be held in your child's classroom. (except Angels & Little Lambs which will be held in Room 103.)

Costume Parade/Party Day

Though many other customs of Halloween are not in keeping with our biblical emphasis, LCNS applauds the value and fun in dressing up in costumes and pretending; therefore the children are invited to wear costumes for our parade. Each child will have a specially decorated bag to transport their costume and party favors home at the end of the day.

We ask that you avoid costumes that depict scary, evil or violent characters including weapons of any kind.

Directions for Costume Parades

A. Drop off: bring children to the classroom in their costume.

B. For 3, 4 and 5 year old classes

Families go to Family Life Center and stand in the center of the room.

The teachers will bring the classes down at 9:40 am or 12:55 pm and the children will parade around the outside of the room two times. There is plenty of time for pictures. We will end the parade with a group picture for each class.

C. For 2 year old classes

Families go to Room 105 beside the school office. The teachers will bring the children down at 10:00 am. The children will parade around the room and you can take group pictures at that time.

D. Conclusion of each parade:

Classes will return to their rooms in their costumes. Teachers and designated party helpers will help take off the costumes.
