### **St Patrick's Day Celebrations**

The children are invited to wear green. The children will hear a knock on the door (by the "leprechaun"). They will follow the "foot prints" (placed by our volunteers) of the leprechaun in search for the pot of gold. The reward for their search throughout the building is hearing a story about leprechauns and receiving a piece of gold from the pot of gold. When the children return to the classroom, they will find that the "leprechaun" (our volunteers) have made a mess in the room, with overturned chairs, coats strewn about, and more.
