Easter Hat Parade

Each year we ask our families to participate in this home-school activity and work with their child to decorate a hat for our hat parade. It is so much fun to see all your great ideas. We have seen great baseball hats with Easter eggs and grass, headbands with eggs and bunnies and picture hats decked out with tiny stuffed animals.

Directions for the Hat Parade

A. Drop off: bring children to the classroom with the hat.

B. For 3, 4, and 5 year old classes

Families go to Family Life Center and stand in the center of the room.

The teachers will bring classes down at 9:40 am or 12:55 pm and the children will parade around the outside of the room two times. There is plenty of time for pictures. We will end the parade with a group picture for each class.

C. For 2 year old classes

Families go to the room beside the school office and/or the hallway behind the Sanctuary. The teachers will bring the children down at 10:00 am. The children will parade around the hallway and you can take a group picture in the room beside the school office.

D. Conclusion of each parade

Classes will return to their rooms in their hats. Teachers and designated party helpers will help take off hats.

Easter Egg Hunt & Party

Our annual egg hunt is another fun activity. Families will be asked to donate plastic eggs. Look for signs posted outside each classroom for eggs and party goodies. Party helpers will be preparing games.

Have your child bring a basket for the egg hunt. This event is a class activity rather than a family activity.
